INFRASTRUCTURE

Over the years, Nandhanaa Garments has developed Its Infrastructure vigilantly by Incorporating all the core facilities to enable hassle-free production. A complete network management stem Integrating all the production divisions, with parallel Interfacing of the laboratory ensures quality control at each stage of production. Further, the Intensively supervised production process confirms the superior quality of the product.



Knitting

We also have our own knitting division with circular knitting machine and flat knitting machine. The hi-tech machineries help us creating Rib, Interlock and Fancy designs. Fabrics need to be knit appropriately to make them look good and feel perfect.



Sampling

Sampling of garments is given great emphasis. It determines the approval of future orders from buyers and fetches business for a garment manufacturing or export company. Sampling is one of key elements of the pre-production processes in a garment industry.



Cutting

Cutting is separating of the garment into its components and in a general form, it is the production process of separating (sectioning, curving, severing) a spread into garment parts that are the precise size and shape of the pattern pieces on a marker.



Organic Fabric Cutting

Cutting being the first operation of garment manufacturing lays the foundation of quality of the garment to be made. Any imperfection in cutting process can result in non-conformance of the quality standards of all further process.



Stitching

In the textile arts, a stitch is a single turn or loop of thread, or yarn. For stitching of garments we have 200 machines. The over lock and flat lock machines are from Pegaus-Japan and lock stitch are from Juki-Japan. All the machines are fixed with auto thread trimming and dust collection.



Checking

Every garment is subjected thru a initial check in the production on to the line and only then passed on to the separate checking division for a final checking.



Ironing

Pressing or ironing is the most important finishing process in the readymade garments sector which is done by subjecting a cloth to heat and pressure with or without steam to remove unwanted creases and to impart a flat appearance to the garments.



Tagging and label attach

While the garment label requirements of different countries are similar in that these regulations are all in place for consumer protection purposes, there are some important differences between these requirements that you'll need to know about if you want to sell clothing or household textile items internationally.



Quality check

Define quality control check points to be used for testing the product quality at any point in the production process. Quality Control Point is a point or stage of manufacturing where it is essential to control (reduce or eliminate) a risk to avoid downtime.

Packing Division

Here garments are neatly packed with utmost care. We are equipped with high-tech Polybag manufacturing unit with a production capacity of 1200kgs/day. We have a fully equipped carton box manufacturing unit to ensure quality packing. Our production capacity is about 1600kgs/day.



Shipping

Textiles are shipped in a dry van. This type of trailer is one of the most common modes of freight transport on the roads today. A dry van trailer will protect the fabric from the elements and ensure safe travel.
